


Red Stag Carbon-Sustainability & Social Outcomes Statement

Red Stag group is the only New Zealand-based manufacturer of both Cross Laminated Timber (CLT) and Glulam. It is locally family owned.

Environmental – Sustainability - Carbon

Red Stag supplies NZ's lowest carbon building material. This is due to the timber being dried and the site powered by 100% renewable energy from Red Stag's boilers and power turbines. This is how our EPD compares.

Local Employment

Red Stag employs 500+ staff and contractors across our Rotorua, Auckland and Waikato sites. Of these, 49% identify as Māori and approx. 15% Pacifica.

We have 6 young people enrolled in the apprenticeship boost programme (4 of 6 identify as Māori) with support via WINZ, and we are actively recruiting another 3 people. In addition, we have another 4 in a mechanical apprenticeship qualifications.

We source logs from FSC-certified forests that have a very high ratio of Māori workforce. Further, a joint main supplier is partly owned by local iwi, and grows its forest on iwi owned & leased land. As its largest customer, Red Stag is instrumental in helping process more logs in NZ and re-risk over-reliance on China for forest owners & the NZ economy.

Social

Red Stag directly, or through its Foundation, sponsors and supports many sporting, community and cultural initiatives and charities to the value of approximately \$500,000 annually. In addition, we provide 5ha of land for Rotorua's main mountain-biking car park and events, free of charge to the community and for the local tourism economy.
